General Rules & Bye-laws

Remember to always think **"Catch & Release"**.... the fish must return in good condition!!!

- River Deel Open Season is from February 14th to September 30th.
- The River Deel is closed for Salmon & Sea Trout.
- The only legal method to catch freshwater fish is by rod and line.
- Salmon Angling Regulations published by Inland Fisheries Ireland for 2020 require that anglers may only use single barbless hooks on the River Deel, and angling for salmon (any size) and sea trout (over 40cm) is prohibited.
- Always respect the rights & property of the riparian owners by whose courtesy you enjoy the privilege of fishing.
- Discourage all forms of illegal fishing.
- No ground baiting or live baiting.
- A person may fish with not more than two rods at any time.
- A bag limit of 3 brown trout per angler per day.
- Any member has the right to inspect catches.
- Remember to be courteous and mindful of other anglers and respect their place on the river.
- Fishing is prohibited 45 meters (50 yards) either side all weirs in the Askeaton area.
- It is prohibited to take and kill by any means or have possession of trout less than 25 centimetres (10 inches) in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail (fork length)
