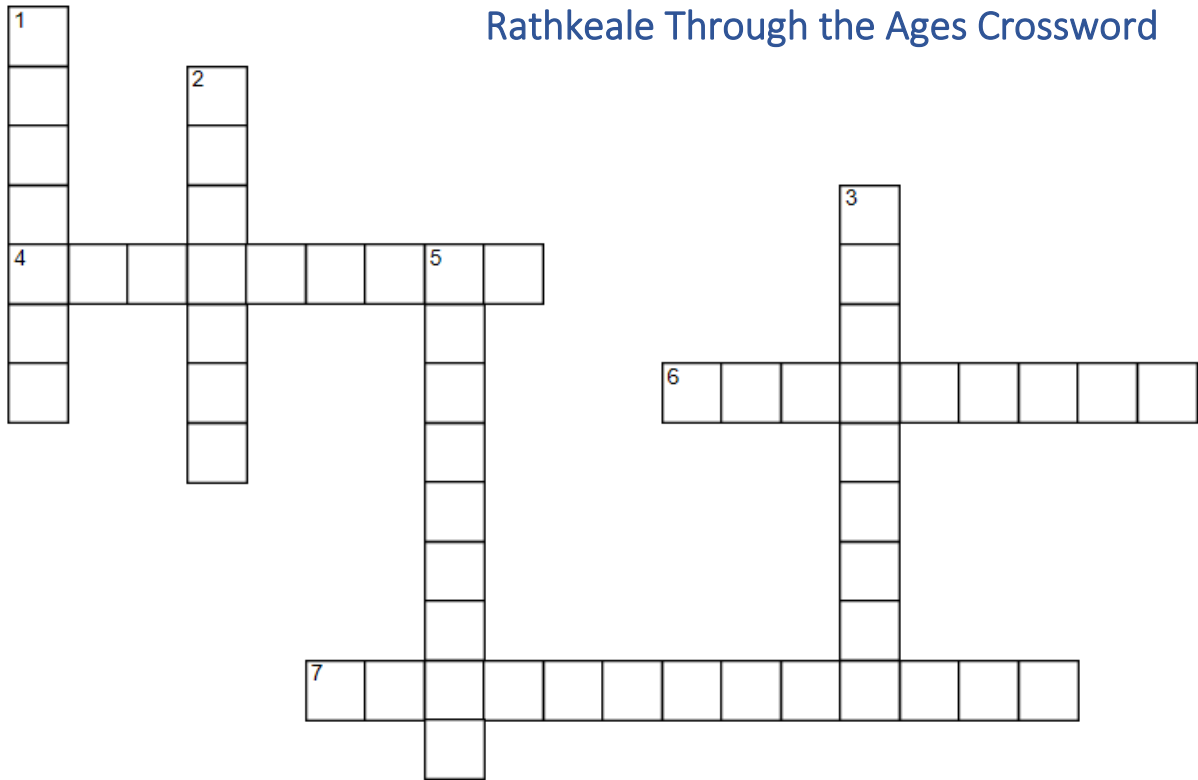


## Rathkeale Through the Ages Crossword
